As one of the world's leading brake system manufacturers, Continental Teves is well known internationally, especially in Europe, where its ATE brand of aftermarket brake products has been installed by automakers for the past century. ATE brake products debuted in North America in the mid-1970s for European import vehicles. Working with an international team of managers, VDI used its e-Publisher software to input files supplied by Teves' German operation, consolidating and linking the data to create a single relational database consisting of thousands of unique, application-specific part numbers.

The system's mapping process allowed Teves' files to be exported in the industry standard AAIA ACES format for delivery to Activant Solutions (CCI/Triad), Wrenthead, and other e-Cat companies.

Thanks to e-Publisher, Teves met its deadline for providing mapped files meeting AAIA requirements when they officially introduced their ATE PremiumOne™ rotor program at the 2005 AAPEX Show last fall. Teves is now using e-Publisher to generate print and CD catalogs, as well as a web application catalog for their customers. VDI continues to serve as the central repository for Teves' application data, enabling Teves' product managers in Auburn Hills, Michigan and Frankfurt, Germany to access and update the data whenever necessary.

"We are extremely pleased with the work that Vertical Development did," said James. "Their data mapping, aftermarket cataloging know-how and rapid response were invaluable to helping us meet critical launch deadlines for the ATE PremiumOne™ program," he added.
